The session provided practical guidance on the procedures for filing patents and copyrights and highlighted ways to protect innovations and creative works effectively. It also helped participants understand the broader intellectual property landscape with greater clarity and confidence.

During the session, Dr. Patil explained the difference between filing a patent and copyrights. Patents protect inventions and innovations, while copyrights safeguard original literary and creative works. He noted that patents are granted for a period of 20 years, whereas copyright protection generally lasts for 60 years. A key requirement for obtaining a patent is novelty and innovation, ensuring that the invention is original and not previously disclosed.

The session also emphasized the importance of conducting a comprehensive literature search and a WIPO (World Intellectual Property Organization) search at the ideation stage before applying for a patent. This helps researchers confirm the originality of their ideas and avoid duplication.

The orientation session was beneficial for faculty members, research scholars, and PhD coordinators, as it provided step by step guidance with practical demonstration on filing the IPR in various categories.

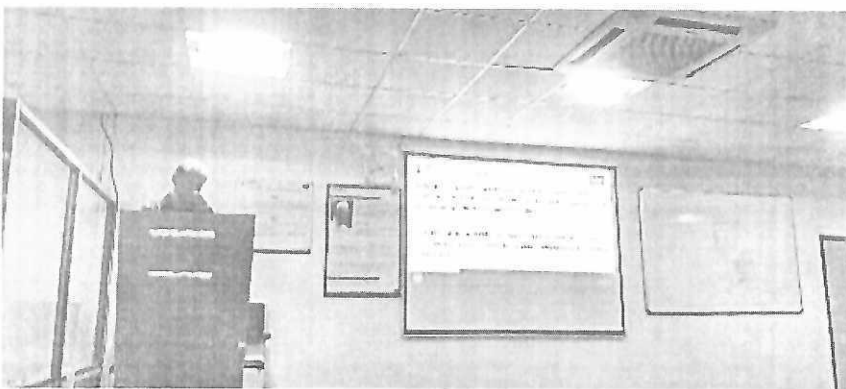
